- 1. Mary Anderson –Shared Registration Information for 5th graders registering for 6th grade at Draper Park Middle School
 - a. Reviewed Registration cards and processes

- 2. SNAP Plan Review- Tracy reviewed SNAP plan submitted to the district for recommended modifications for our pick up and drop off areas.
 - a. Text descriptions of walking routes will be on our school website when the district has approved our school SNAP Plan
 - b. It is recommended that the crossing guard on the corner of High Mesa and Lone Eagle be a position that remains for the following school year.
 - c. It is recommended that the width of 2220 E. be widened (by removing grass strip) to allow parents to pull in off the road to drop off students.
 - d. We ask that the district consider Lone Peak Elementary School as a priority for plowing snow.
 - e. We'd like an occasional police officer to visit our school during the very busy times of drop-off and pick up to help address the hazards.
- 3. Feedback from School Surveys
 - a. Strengths
 - i. parents feel staff treat parents and students with respect
 - b. Areas to Improve
 - i. Pick up and Drop off- we are working on this (see item 2)
 - ii. Communicating student progress- we are working on coming up with options to better communicate with parents.
- 4. Red Tickets and Behavior Data
 - a. Strengths
 - i. Not many office referrals
 - ii. Students really like red tickets and Principal's Pride
 - iii. High Number of tickets are being given out

- b. Areas to Improve
 - i. Some teachers/students interact with red tickets less often- BLT is reviewing data with team and the teachers are tracking red tickets
 - ii. Lunch recess is the highest referral time- lunch times have been staggered this year to reduce the number of kids on the playground during lunch and that has helped to reduce the amount of referrals.
- 5. SRI Results from mid-year (measures student comprehension of text)
 - a. 4th grade- There were about 63 points of growth between the beginning of the year to mid-year. The goal is 100 points of growth by the end of the year.
 - b. 5th grade- there were about 35 points of growth between the beginning of the year to mid-year. The goal is 100 points of growth by the end of the year.
- 6. Informal Data from Writing Assessments
 - a. 3 are given to each child each year (2 informative and one opinion); one has been given so far.
 - i. Results indicated that students need more instruction on creating strong topic sentences and also answering the prompt being given.
 - ii. There has been an increase in the strength of writing teaching this year.
- 7. Looking forward to next year's plan- next steps
 - a. This year our Trust Lands money was spent on TA's to push into classrooms and also for science materials.
 - i. Ideas for next year- money for more technology in the classroom, TA's, and science materials.
 - ii. Tracy will get feedback from the teachers for what their preferences are.
