- CSIP Goals
 - a. They are the same as was listed in May 2016. They are posted in the school by the office.
 - i. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade students will increase SAGE results by 5% in the area of reading and writing. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year 85% of Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade students will show proficiency in the area of writing informational text as measured by standards based write on demand tasks.
 - ii. By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, 4th and 5th grade students at Lone Peak Elementary will increase their science proficiency from 58%

proficient to 68% proficient. 85% of students in grades K-3 will demonstrate proficiency in writing about science as measured by write on demand tasks related to science content.

- iii. By the end of the 2016-2107 school year, teachers at Lone Peak Elementary will reward a varied population of students in many locations as measured by the red ticket tracker shared at monthly BLT meetings.
