1. Hazardous Route Study

Input to see if bus routes still need to be in place.

Wasatch route – concerns are: having to walk on Wasatch Blvd to get to school. The sidewalks disappear.

2. Mascot/Logo

Modernize the logo a little bit. Current letterhead is a little boring, and non-Elementary-ish. Fifteen different options for logos were presented.

Graphic designer ideas to help us with feedback and design was requested. Alta High Students may be a resource to generate a modern logo.

Principal Robinson will contact art teachers at the High School level and students will be contacted to see if that is an option.

3. Parent Survey

Survey monkey – could set up the link on our website and invite parents to take the survey on the Internet. PTA has 80% of the email addresses of students at Lone Peak. Ultimate goal is to see what our school needs to be able to write our Land Trust and CSIP application. This will assess our weaknesses, which will help us to develop a plan for the future.

4. Fundraiser

History: compiling a list to provide the District with information.

The SCC did not do a separate fundraiser last year or this year. When an individual class does a fundraiser, it counts for the whole school. Per year, district policy is that

the PTA can have one fundraiser, the SCC can have one fundraiser, and the school can have two fundraisers to benefit a non-profit, approved organization.

Mrs. Heward's class is interested in doing a fundraiser for those in Haiti. This fundraiser, if done, would replace "Jump for Heart". There may be an organization that would match moneys that are raised here.

Principal Robinson will talk with Mrs. Ramey to clear up "Jump for Heart". Julia Winfree will work with Mrs. Heward with finding a non-profit to go through and a story to highlight. A possible assembly to kick off this fundraiser is felt would be effective. Look out for video clips to show at an assembly.
