Agenda Items:

- Follow-up on "Using the Trust" – DVD and sign of sheet
 - a. Leslie Guido, Jody Katz - need to sign off
- Land trust plan and final report
 - a. Final Report due June 1
 - Principal Robinson will put something together and present it for approval.
 - Exact dollar amount not known yet. approx. \$5,000–7,000 less than last year.
- District response to the racism incident at Alta
 - a. District protocol is to put administrators on paid leave during investigation.
 - b. Dr. Doty went to language arts classes at Alta to discuss racism and current issues.
 - c. Parent meeting was held which Jody Katz was invited to attend.
 - d. Diversity Training is in the works for students in the near future.
 - e. Letter went out to all families that have kids attending schools that feed into Alta
- Legislative changes to SCC process
 - a. Jim handed out the amendment and a synopsis from Paula Plant.
 - b. Standardized elections which will be open for 3 days and held no later than the 1st 30 days of school.
 - c. SCC Meeting etc. will be held in accordance with the law - Principal Robinson will have to sign for compliance.
 - d. Line 51-53 - If a parent is the chair, and then the vice-chair needs to be a certified

- employee. Co-chairs if 2 there are 2 parent volunteers.
- e. Majority of total number of members on the SCC present are required and represent a quorum needed to conduct business.
 - f. Laws that pertain to SCC need to be distributed to each member each year.
 - g. School Boards may disapprove the Land Trust Plan but cannot make changes.
 - h. See House bill 152 for more information-copies were distributed to members in attendance.
- District boundary steering committee update
 - a. Presenting a roll-out plan tomorrow night to board. 2 options for schools. Open houses for parents with computers where you will type in your address and it will show you, based on the options, where your child will attend and then public comment will be taken in writing. Adjustment will be made and then the Board can pick an option or come up with their own solution.
 - b. Lone Peak boundaries currently are similar. Discrepancies in time line for announcing the decision but should be in effect for Fall 2013.
 - c. One of the biggest issues is going to be that there is not enough money to build a big enough high school for all the kids in Draper.
 - d. Middle school boundaries will be the most challenging because those schools will have a capacity of 800-900 kids.
 - Huntsman Award was written and we will find out the middle of May.
 - SCC Members may remain on the committee after their child leaves the school if the member was elected while their child attended said school.
