Minutes:

1. Members of the SCC watched the "Touch the Future" training DVD together and signed off for watching it.
2. We will hold off on providing the new rules, laws, and requirements for School Community Councils until after the District SCC training at Jordan High School on October 6th, 2011.
3. Updates on the Trust Land funds from last year.
 - a. There was a drop in the scores for 5th Grade from 2010 to 2011 from Language Arts and Math. This decrease was a district wide change based upon the discrepancy and changes from the curriculum and the tests for that year.
 - b. There were 5 instructional assistants that were hired to help teachers with Tier II interventions. The focus was on math and reading. This was a cost of \$37,800 (total) for all five instructors for the year.
 - c. For this year's plan, we hired 4 instructional assistants to help with Tier II interventions. Additional funds are being used for professional development and materials to help teachers with their Tier I interventions. If additional funds are substantial enough, an additional assistant will be hired.
4. The Excellent Eagles Big 3 Program to promote respect, responsibility, and safety at Lone Peak was explained by Principal Robinson. This program is used to make Lone Peak a more positive and uplifting place of learning. We have seen great results so far throughout the building.
5. Elections for the next School Year- We discussed having school elections for School Community Council for next year's council. The Elections would possibly be on "Back to School Night." More discussion on this will take place throughout the year. We discussed providing information about the School Community Council and elections during the

Student Registration process at the beginning of the year. It was also discussed that we need to maintain more parents than hired staff, but also a balance and keeping the group from becoming too large.

6. Discussion of boundaries for the upcoming changes for the school district. A decision will be made by School Board regarding school boundaries.

The meeting was adjourned until the next meeting on October 10, 2011.
