Agenda Items

1. Welcome (Jim) Welcomed the council members.
2. Current Year Plan and Budget Report (Principal Stacy) – Current year budget and expenses are on track for this year and we expect to use all of this years allocated Land Trust Funds.
3. School Safety: Pick up and Drop off (Principal Stacy) – Reviewed the Pick-up and Drop-off situation at Lone Peak. It was reported that Principal Stacy has been in contact with the district and Sandy city to try and come up with a solution to the traffic and parking lot issues during drop off and pick up times. At this point there are no solutions and the school will continue to work with the district and city and try and develop a plan.
