Agenda Items

1. Welcome -Jim welcomed everyone to the SCC meeting.
2. Current Year Plan and Budget Report -Principal Stacy gave an update on the current year budget and expenditures and budget. As of the date of this meeting the use of the Land Trust Funds seem to be on track to be used by the end of the year.
3. SNAP plan information -Principal Stacy expressed concern regarding the parking during drop off and pick up times. She reports that some parents have been refusing to follow the rules which have been communicated to parents several times. There have also been reports of some parents refusing to follow staff instructions during these times thereby putting children at risk in the parking lot. She reported that she has recently been in communication with several employees from the district to look at the situation and try and develop a better system of pick up and drop off. She is requesting any suggestions to deal with this issue.
4. Unpacking process for meeting our CSIP goals. Principal Stacy gave an update on the “unpacking” process and the potential effects on the sage testing.
5. School Survey – Principal Stacy reviewed the survey which was done last fall. Most questions were scored between 3.5 and 4.0 on a 4.0 scale. The low areas were related to the parking lot during pickup and drop off times.
6. PTA Update – Lisanne reported on white ribbon day, principals pride, college week and the Chinese New Year celebration. She also reported the PTA has earned around \$2000 on box tops. Lisanne explained to the SCC that she gave the PTA board a small thank you gift for all their hard work, she explained any cost associated with this thank you gift came from her personally and no PTA funds were used.
