1. Reviewed Testing Scores for 2012 school year. AYP was the previously used standard, UCAS was reviewed by Principal Robinson as it's the current system being used.

2. Safety and wellbeing of students of Lone Peak

4. Land Trust Money for 2013-2014 school year.
