1. **Welcome** (Jim) Jim welcomed the SCC and discussed some of the highlights from the SCC training. The big takeaways were we should meet every month and the principle should be reporting how we are performing to this year's budget. The goal is for the money allocated to be used each year.

We will be having a White Ribbon Day on January 20th. The goal will be to discuss Internet safety. The program we will be using is "Net Safe."

It was suggested that parents update themselves on the policy decisions made by the Canyons Board using the public website or attending the board meetings. As always the Lone Peak SCC encourages parent involvement. Principal Stacy is going to reach out the proper way to communicate to parents how the immersion program will work in high school.
