Proof of Residency Checklist

General Proof of Residency

The parent or legal guardian of the student must provide a valid form of identification as well as the following items listed below to the school. (Must show Two)
Rental, lease or purchase agreement for the claimed residence where the student resides (see column A: Utah Public Schools Proof of Residency Model Procedures) Most recent gas, electric or water bill that shows the "service" address. We will not accept just the payment stub that shows the mailing address. (see column B: Utah Public Schools Proof of Residency Model Procedures)
 If the above information is not available, the school may request additional documentation for open-ended or month-to-month leases.
Valid driver's license or form of identification and
Any TWO alternative documents showing current address
Most recent payroll stub Most recent credit card statement Current vehicle registration Valid passport Voter registration documentation Church or religious records W-2 form (dated within the past year) Property tax bill (dated within the past year) Valid Driver License showing current address
The following <u>do not</u> establish residency: Property owned in school district boundaries PO box in school district boundaries Letters from friends or relatives

UTAH STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION UTAH PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROOF OF RESIDENCY MODEL PROCEDURES

Before a student is enrolled in a Utah public school, the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must show proof of Utah residency in the school district in which the student desires to enroll. (UC.A. 53A-2-201)

Below are examples of documentation a school may request to show residency:

Note: THIS IS A MODEL ONLY. School personnel should determine the forms of documentation necessary to satisfy residency requirements for public school enrollment. It is not necessary for school personnel to retain documentation provided by a student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) once residency has been confirmed.

The following do not establish residency:

- Powers of attorney
- · Letters from friends or relatives

- Property owned in Utah school district boundaries
- · P.O. box in school district boundaries
